Key features

Qualification Structure

- The Edexcel BTEC Level 2 First Award in Art and Design is taught over 120 guided learning hours (GLH). It has core and optional specialist units.
- Learners must complete the two core units, and a choice of optional units to reach a total of 120 GLH.
- The BTEC First Award has a unit that Edexcel sets, is marked internally before being moderated by the exam board.
