The aim of the BTEC in Music is to:

- Inspire and enthuse learners to consider a career in the music industry.
- Give learners an opportunity to gain a broad knowledge and understanding of, and develop skills in, the music industry, e.g. the live sound industry, solo or group professional performance, or music promotion.
- Support progression to a more specialised vocational or academic music course or apprenticeship
- Give learners the potential opportunity to enter employment within a wide range of junior job roles across the music industry.
